Anti-Entrapment Declaration and Installation Certification

Revisions to the California Health and Safety Code Section 115920, known as the Swimming Pool Safety Act, came into effect January 1, 2007. Section 115928, Subsection (d) and as amended, effective January 1, 2008, states that, "Whenever a building permit is issued for the remodel or modification of an existing swimming pool, toddler pool, or spa, the permit shall require that the suction outlet of the existing swimming pool, toddler pool, or spa be upgraded so as to be equipped with an anti-entrapment cover meeting current standards of the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) or the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME)."

In order to comply with state law, all homeowners are required at the same time of a permit issuance be made aware of this new legislation, and if applicable, that they comply.

For properties that do not have an existing swimming pool, toddler/wader pool, or spa, we request that the owner declare in writing that a swimming pool, toddler/wader pool, or spa does not exist on site.

For properties that do have an existing swimming pool, toddler/wader pool, or spa we require you indicate whether the permit request includes work to be performed on the swimming pool, toddler/wader pool, or spa. If work will be performed on a swimming pool, toddler/wader pool, or spa then an anti-entrapment drain cover device must be part of the scope of work under the requested permit. The anti-entrapment drain cover device must be installed and verified by a building inspector prior to final inspection. This document will be filed as a permanent record in the city permit files.

This declaration will be submitted with the building permit for the remodel or modification to an existing or new swimming pool, toddler/wader pool, or spa.

An additional permit may be required if the pool must be altered to install an additional suction outlet. Contact a licensed pool contractor for additional information.

Applicant shall retain the packaging and documentation from the anti-entrapment cover for inspector verification.

NOTES:

An anti-vortex cover is not the same as an anti-entrapment cover.

The only classification of license permitted to perform the installation of the drain covers is a C-53 and/or C-61/D35.
